#### VICE PRESIDENT

It shall be the duty of the Vice President to:

- Work in conjunction with the President to develop and fulfill the goals, mission, and mandate of NSO through said duties, responsibilities, and activities of the President
- Chair executive meetings and the Annual General Meeting (AGM) meeting when the President is absent
- Provide leadership and undertake the duties of President over the NSO when the President is absent.
- Perform such duties as assigned by the executive or President
- Attend as an alternate all AGMs, Board of Directors meetings, Assemblies, and conferences (RNAO, ONA, CNA, CUPN, CAAT, CNSA, and IG's) where NSO representation is needed and where the President is unable to attend.
- In collaboration with the President, prepare and manage an annual budget for NSO activities that includes: workshops, conferences, meetings, town halls, and joint ventures with other student, nursing, and inter-professional groups, organizations, and associations
- Be responsible for incorporating charitable work into the administration of NSO
- Act as an ambassador for RNAO and NSO.
- Act as the liaison between NSO and CNSA.
- Support and maintain membership through diverse activities.

The Vice President:

- Has voting privileges in the governance and administration of NSO – has one (1) vote
- Is a democratically elected position.
- Must have at least one (1) previous year of experience on the NSO Executive
